

# 2023 New Year Summer Show Jumping Series

**Series Rounds:** Wed 18 Jan, Wed 25 Jan, Wed 01 Feb, Series Final - Wed 08 Feb.

**Series Prize Giving:** Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2023

**Series Points:** Series Points from just 3 of the 4 evenings will be accumulated.  
You choose the evenings that suit you best to enter.

**Series Levels:** Nominate the Level at which you want to compete.

We hope to see you at all four of the shows but only the points earned from your best 3 nominated classes will be accumulated to decide the Series Winners. However, there will be a Bonus Point awarded for entering and competing in all four Shows of the Summer Series. **In this Series you can only jump in your nominated Level**

### Important notes

- Entries open at [www.abderry.co.nz/Events](http://www.abderry.co.nz/Events)
- Because we will only be running one Jumping Ring, we have limited slots in each class. Be sure to enter ASAP to secure your space in our series
- You may enter up to 3 x classes/rounds per show (only 1 class counts towards series points)
- Each Horse and Rider combination can only compete in one Series. Series points are accumulated from one nominated class in this Series at three shows of your choice. This class must be nominated before the combination's first round of competition at each show.
- **If no nomination is made, the first competition class will be counted.**
- Please indicate your nominated class when you enter and confirm this class with the judges before your first round of the show.
- **Bonus points:** 1 pt for competing at all 4 Shows in the Summer Series
- Horses & Ponies will jump the same courses. There will be no combination fences
- You may enter the same class twice, however only your *first round* will count towards series points.
- NB - It may be possible to win a class on the evening with your 2nd or 3rd round of the Class but only your first round will count for Series Points

We've had a couple of questions about accruing Series points

Q: If I nominate Class 3, 70cm to accrue Level Zero Series Points can I jump in the lowest class of Level One - Class 4 75cm

A: Yes. But you cannot jump in Level One - Class 5 80cm

Q: If on a subsequent evening in the series I want to jump in Level One - Class 5 80cm can I still nominate Class 3 70cm as my nominated class to accrue Level Zero Series Points?

A: No. You cannot use Level Zero Class 3 70cm as your nominated Class if you jump in Level One - Class 5 80cm. By entering and jumping in Class 5 80cm you are considered to be competing in the Level One Series.

Q: If I do jump in Level One - Class 5 80cm will the Level Zero Series Points I accrued previously by nominating Class 3 (which is Level Zero) be counted in my Level One Series tally.

A: No.

Hopefully, this helps to clarify the situation.

## Series Points Allocation

Points will be allocated for each class as follows:

*(Eliminations, retirements or greater than 12 faults will not gain points regardless of class numbers.)*

Points	Assuming 5 + Eligible Entries	If less than 5 Eligible Entries
1st	5	5
2nd	4	4
3rd	3	3
4th	2	2
5th	1	

Eligible Entries = 1st Rounds in a Class & Completed rounds with less than 12 faults

Abderry reserves the right to alter points allocation in unforeseen circumstances (such as an event called off half-way through) and to refuse entries where they are deemed inappropriate or unsafe. Judges' decisions are final.
